



RETURN TO DISTANCE LEARNING TIMELINE

November 13, 2020

Due to changes in health data and an increase in COVID-19 cases, MSA has decided to transition to distance learning over the next few weeks and prioritize the health and safety of our students and staff. Below is a timeline explaining the steps we will take. As we transition our pods to different learning models, we will have pivot days in which there will be no classes or services. Teachers and staff working in the pods that will be changing to a different model will use the pivot days to prepare for the transition. *Students and classes already in distance learning will continue in that model.



11/12/20:

11/20/20 - 11/23/20:

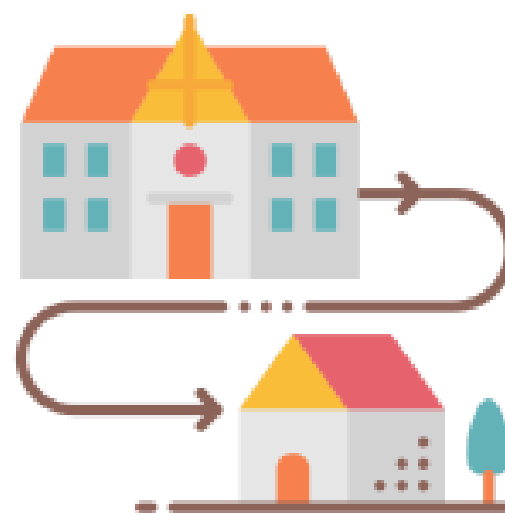
